_____ **Rockets**

The boys will learn about rockets, how they fly, and build their own water powered rocket out of a 2 liter bottle.

_____ **Knife Making**

Each boy will begin the week with a knife blank they will forge into a real knife complete with handle and knife sheath. This class is limited to 20 boys who have completed 5th grade or above. Boys will need long pants and closed shoes.

_____ **Drone Flying**

In this class the boys will learn to fly drones and how they can be used in the real world.

_____ **Auto Mechanics**

Boys will learn some of the basics of maintaining a vehicle.

_____ **Woodworking**

The boys will complete woodworking projects that they will be able to take home with them. The class is limited to 20 campers.

_____ **Horticulture**

Boys will learn about plants and gardening.

_____ **Outdoor Cooking**

In this class the boys will learn how to cook outside over a fire and get to sample what they cook.

_____ **Welding**

The Boys will learn the basics of welding as they put together a new grill for the camp. This class is limited to 20 boys who have completed 5th grade or above. They will need long pants, long sleeves and closed shoes. Other safety equipment will be provided at camp.

_____ **Flint Knapping**

Learn the art of making arrowheads and other flint tools the way they would have been made by tribal people around the world.
