

ETBE COVID-19 Policies Summer Camp 2021

We are excited about the prospect of having camp once again this summer and are looking forward to hosting campers of all ages. Governor Gregg Abbott has lifted most of the restrictions regarding limiting the spread of the covid-19 virus. The goal of ETBE is to maintain the safety of all our guests while they reside on our campus. With this in mind ETBE will be continuing the following to make sure that everyone has a positive camp experience:

- 1) Churches will complete a screening roster listing each camper arriving at camp. This roster will verify the camper has a normal temperature, is not currently displaying symptoms of covid-19, and has not been in close contact with a person who tested positive for the virus.
- 2) ETBE food service will continue not providing any self-serve food items in the dining hall. In addition salt, peper, and all other condiments will be provided in individual packages.
- 3) ETBE cleaning staff will sanitize each restroom facility according to state health standards across the campus daily. Dorms will also be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized between camp sessions.
- 4) Restroom facilities will have hand soap and sanitizer at every sink and hand sanitizer stations will be scattered across the campus.
- 5) Any camper displaying symptoms will be referred to the camp nurse, isolated from all other campers, and picked up by a parent.
- 6) Visitors to ETBE will need to check in at the camp office and complete the screen process.
